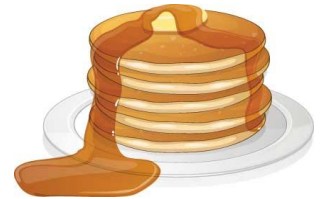

SHROVE TUESDAY PANCAKE SUPPER – FEBRUARY 13th

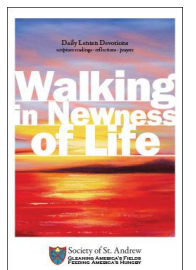
