Following today's worship service, please join us for a reception in the Fellowship Hall.

Thank you to all the people, young and old, who supported the Food Drive. You collected over forty crates (plus numerous plastic bags) of nutritious food and needed supplies, which were taken directly to the SHARE Food Pantry to restock its shelves. This will feed and support scores of needy families and individuals in our community.

This food drive, Sat. March 2, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., was staffed by 25+ volunteers, including five Boy Scouts: Steve Lourenco, Judge Chalk (6 hours), Harold Heller, Ryan Hopper, and Joshua Jarasilo. I believe all worked at least 4 hours. They came from either Troop 1130 or Troop 869.

Seventy-five \$10 bags with needed SHARE items were pre-assembled and sold at the food drive (thanks to help from the Scouts and Safeway personnel). We collected \$250 in gift cards and cash during the drive. The money was immediately used to buy needed items for the food pantry.


