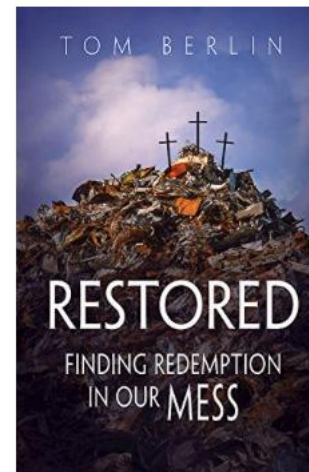

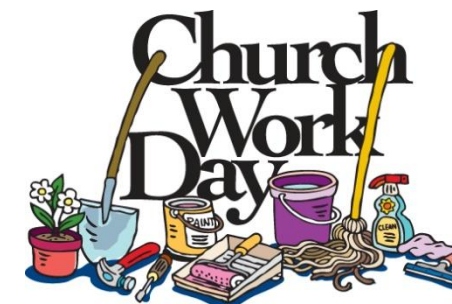


LENTEN BIBLE STUDY
