A labyrinth is a path which leads, via a circuitous route, to the center of an intricate design and back out again. It's a safe space to think about our relationships with ourselves, one another, our planet and God. Unlike a maze, a labyrinth is easy to navigate. Each person walks the labyrinth in their sock feet at their own pace and for their own reasons. There is no pressure and people are silent.
