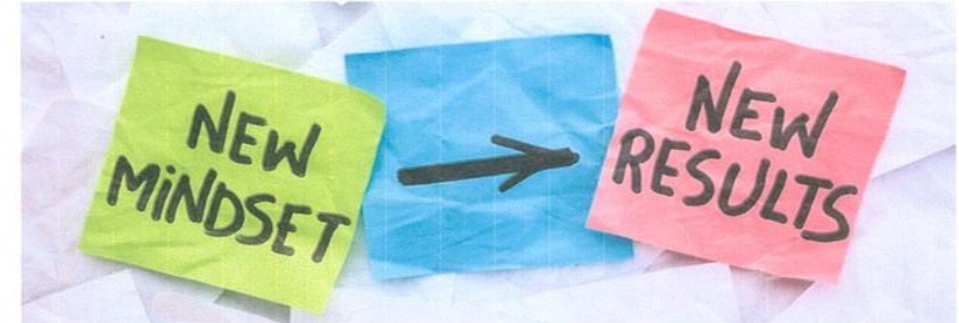

## Developing and Implementing an Outward Mindset



In a world plagued with conflict and anxiety, having real conversations can be extremely difficult. Plan to spend two days this fall learning how to process these anxieties and reframe your reactions.

**When:** Friday/Saturday, September 28 -29 from 8:00 a.m.—4:30 p.m.

**Where:** St. Stephen's UMC (9203 Braddock Rd., Burke, VA 22015)

**Cost:** \$75/person\* (includes lunch both days)

In this workshop, participants learn the difference between an inward mindset (a myopic focus on personal objectives) and an outward mindset (taking into account one's impact on others). They begin to discover the extent to which they have been working from an inward mindset and understand the implications of this mindset on their work and on those around them. This interactive, two-day course allows participants to thoroughly explore and internalize key concepts in discussions led by an Arbinger-certified facilitator.

This workshop is part of our continuing partnership with laity and clergy to help prepare for the 2019 Called General Conference.

\*The full cost of this workshop is \$135/participant plus lunch, but we are offering this 2-day session to Arlington and Alexandria participants for only \$75/person.
